

IMPORTANT NOTICE CONCERNING ATTORNEY ADDRESSES ON BOARD'S WEBSITE:

Please note that the office address is the address used by the Board for its official correspondence with attorneys. If you are an **active** attorney and you do not have an office or a business address, the Board's website will use your residential address as your business address, which is public information.

If you wish to keep your office or residential address confidential from the public, **the Board will accept a post office box for either your office or residential, but not both.** The Board requires that one of your registered addresses be a street address for the purpose of service when necessary.

If you registered under inactive or retirement status, only the city, state and zip code of the address will appear on the Board's website.

SJC RULE REGARDING BUSINESS EMAIL ADDRESSES AND ADDRESS CHANGES

The Supreme Judicial Court amended Rule 4:02 effective July 1, 2014 to require that attorneys submit a business email address on the annual registration form. Attorneys are required to update their addresses (including the email address) within fourteen days of a change.

Address changes must be updated using the online registration system. Go to the website at massbbo.org and click "Login". Once logged in, click on your name located at the upper right-hand side of the homepage and choose 'My Profile'. Click the "Edit" button to enter any address changes and click the "Save" button after updating the changes. If you need to update more information that will affect your registration, you may click "Go To Registration" to access the online registration form.
